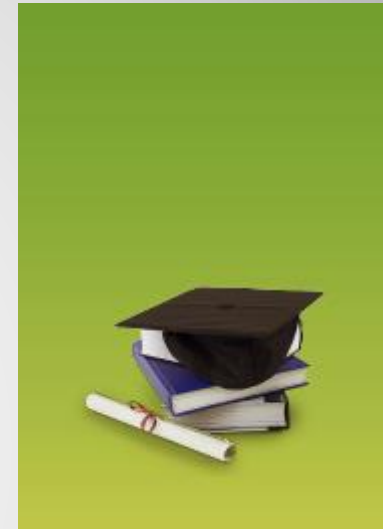
Why Become a Mentor?

- Play a pivotal role in a young mind's life and light a torch for your mentee's path to success



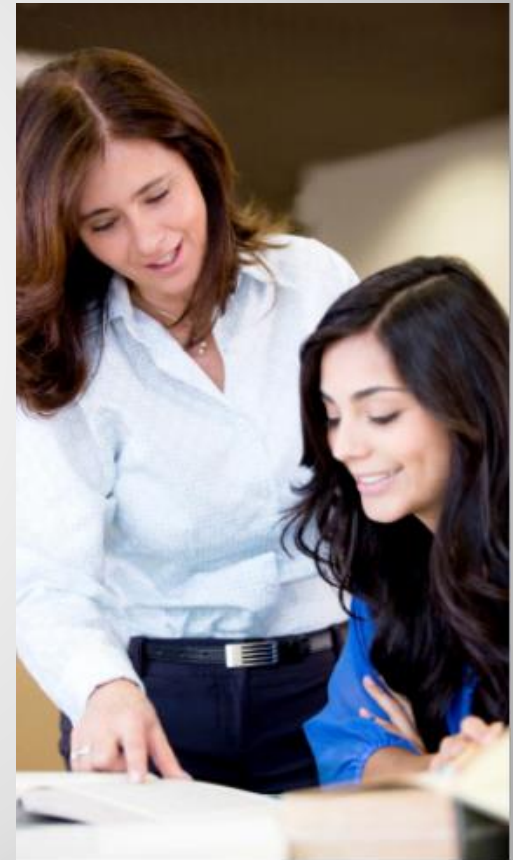
Who Are Mentees?

- Mentees are awarded a \$1000 college scholarship each year of CAMP participation



Pairing Mentors and Mentees

- CAMP pairs mentors and mentees with similar professional interests and career goals as per their profile information and one-on-one interviews

- Help a mentee become the first in their family to graduate college
- Provide real-world life and work experiences that mentee would not have otherwise
- Give opportunities for your mentee to build his/her resume
- Offer valuable networking opportunities

CAMP's Role

- Pairs mentors with mentees
- Connect you to your mentee
- Provides step-by-step instructions via easy-to-use online portal
- Organizes social events and workshops to maximize the effectiveness of the program



Lead Your Mentees Through Program Completion

3 Program Areas:

- **Personal Development:** *Helping your mentee chart a course for success in college, career, and life (service, reading, advice, college guidance)*
- **Job Shadowing:** *Providing real-world exposure to your profession*
- **Project Completion:** *Assigning professional-level work and providing feedback on presentation skills*



Time Commitment

- Over the course of mentee's college career
- Determine your own schedule
- Minimum program requirements (per year)
 - Assigned reading (1 hour)
 - Assign a relevant book and discuss mentee's book report upon completion in person or by phone/Skype.
 - Service project (1 hour)
 - Job shadowing (8 hours)
 - Project completion (20 minutes)
 - PowerPoint presentation prepared by mentee on a specific assigned subject
